Kathy introduced the new South Central District Representative, Brian Grindrod to the board as he has taken Lou Santo's place at this time.

Kathy explained that at the July 30th US Youth AGM many rule changes were voted on amending the current National Championship Series Competition's Policies.

A major change was expanding the roster size of the U14 and U15 from 18 to 22 – thus having U14 – U19 with a maximum roster of 22. Also changed was the minimum roster size of these same age groups from 7 to 9.

Tony Carvalho spoke in favor of adopting these changes for the premier league as well as State Cup.

Motion was made by Tom Mattera:

Adopt policy changes by US Youth for the National Championship for both the CJSA State Cup and the Premier League.

Seconded by Tom Skarbek

Vote: unanimous

Another change is the transfer of premier players within a club – these roster changes will no longer be considered one of the 5 previously rostered players on a premier team. All changes will be effective immediately.

The next CJSA BOD meeting will be September 12th. The October meeting has been changed to the 3rd.
